

Annex A: Behaviour Principles during Covid-19 return to school

In light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school, the following information will need to be adhered to and communicated to the pupils, parents and staff.

Upon their return to school, pupils must adhere to the points outlined below, in addition to the usual Behaviour Policy.

All pupils **must**:

- follow any altered routines for arrival or departure, as explained by your teachers
- follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising, as described by your teacher and on notices around the school
- follow the strict instructions about who you can socialise with at school
- move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing)
- follow the information about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- tell an adult if you are feeling unwell
- follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles and snacks
- follow the new rules about break and lunch times, including where you may or may not play
- only use the toilets allocated to you
- make sure you follow rules about coughing or shouting towards any other person
- understand that the rewards and sanction system will continue to be used where appropriate
